MEM20422 - CERTIFICATE II IN ENGINEERING PATHWAYS

Dear Parents/Carers,

The Certificate II in Engineering Pathways course is open to students in Year 10, 11 and 12 in 2025 in addition to their regular school studies. This course has been developed by Skills Generation (RTO 41008) and is facilitated by the College using a full suite of resources provided by Skills Generation that includes all learning and assessment materials. Please refer to the attached brochure that provides further information about the course.

Students will be required to attend sessions outside of their regular school timetable. Sessions will be Tuesday and Thursday before school from 7:30am to 8:20am. Students can earn up to 4 QCE credits on successful completion of this course.

For students to access this course for free, they can utilise their VETiS funding. VETiS funding is provided by the Department of Employment, Small Business, and Training (DESBT) and covers the cost of **ONE** VETiS qualification listed on the Priority Skills List while the student is in Years 10, 11 or 12. If your child uses this funding for this course, they will not be eligible to access VETiS funding for any future courses. If your child wishes to pursue additional qualifications while still in school, they may be eligible for alternative funding options such as User Choice, Higher Level Skills, or the Certificate 3 Guarantee. Alternatively, they can enrol in a "Fee For Service" course.
