At our end of year **Awards Assembly**, we present several students with special awards for academic achievement and personal growth, along with our Accumulative Sports Awards. Academic Achievement	 Academic Achievement Awards are presented to our highest achieving students in Stage 2 who have achieved academic excellence within their cohort. Dux and Proxime Accessit Awards are presented to our highest achieving Year 5 and 6 students.
Academic Growth	Academic Growth Awards are presented to one student per class, Prep – Year 6, who has demonstrated substantial academic growth and effort throughout the year.
Service Learning	Service Learning awards are presented to one student per class in Prep – Year 6, who demonstrates commitment to engaging in or initiating service opportunities that add value to the lives of others in our community.





• Personal Growth awards are presented to one student per class in Prep – Year 6, who demonstrates a commitment to personal transformation in an area of their life.
• Skills Development awards are presented to one student per class from Prep – Year 6 who demonstrate personal commitment to developing the Learning Habits skills.
 Gold, Silver and Bronze Sport commendations are presented to students in Years 3-6. These are based on students' achievement and level of participation in a variety of Interhouse, Interschool and Queensland School Sports competitions and carnivals across the year. This award recognises two students in Years 3-6 (one male and one female), who have represented Calvary at the highest level, and have made the greatest contribution to sport during the year.
 Junior CPA Awards are presented to those students who have represented Calvary, participating and excelling in a variety of Performing Arts opportunities throughout the year.
